

## World Building Automation Control Systems 2018 (R2018)

### Key Findings

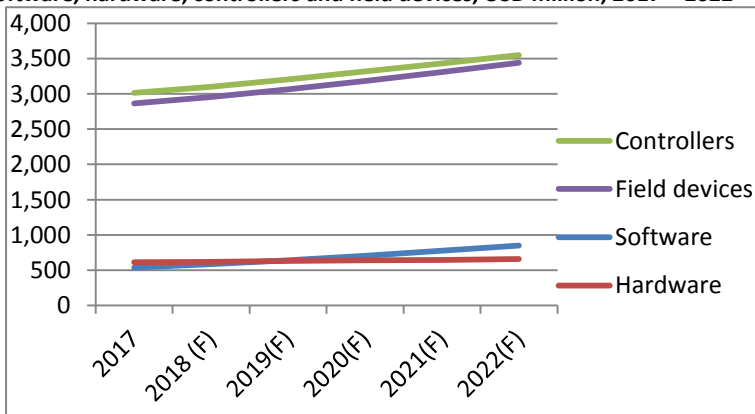
This year's study covers the following countries – **USA, Canada, Sweden, Austria, Switzerland, Saudi Arabia, China, India and SEA** – and addresses intelligent building controls in non-residential buildings and is extended to include all forms of controls such as HVAC, security, lighting and fire safety, installed with or attached to BACS. All reports are in-depth format based on face-to-face interviews with suppliers and the channel which provide high level detail for hardware and software, DDC, field and room controllers and top-line information on field devices. Trends, their impact on the market, IoT and technology are included.

The study covers 23–25 countries on a 1–4 year cycle with 2018 (R2017) report covering: France, Italy, Germany, UK, Poland, Mexico, USA and UAE. So a combination of 16 countries with a benchmark view of the sector and the latest technology developments is included in reports plus data on market sizes, five year forecasts and trends, segmentation, routes to market and major players.
